Rules for Discussion of Reports

- 1. Comments are directed to the Committee Chair
 - This is done to keep focused on the issue and not on the personalities involved
- 2. Reports will be given uninterrupted
- 3. The reporting committee member may ask for questions during the report
- 4. Attendees will be recognized by the Committee Chair by raising his or her hand to comment on the report
- 5. The person giving the report will be given the opportunity to respond to any comments when recognized by the Committee Chair

Rules for Discussion of Questions

- 1. This will apply for members that would like to discuss an issue that may or may not result in a proposal
- 2. Time limit is 5 minutes, the Committee Chair may extend when time expires
- 3. Comments are directed to the Committee Chair
 - This is done to keep focused on the issue and not on the personalities involved
- 4. One committee member should speak at a time
- 5. The committee member speaking or the Committee Chair may designate the next speaker
 - Preference should be given to committee members that have not yet spoken
 - The Committee Chair's designation will take priority as he should assure all members are permitted the opportunity to speak
- 6. Committee members should signal they want to speak by raising his or her hand

Rules for Discussion of Proposals

- 1. Comments are directed to the Committee Chair
 - This is done to keep focused on the issue and not on the personalities involved
- 2. Everyone at the meeting will be given the opportunity to speak uninterrupted
- 3. An attendee can make a motion, or proposal, when recognized by the Committee Chair
- 4. Once a motion is made the Committee Chair will ask for it to be seconded
- 5. Once the motion is seconded, each attendee at the committee meeting will be asked to comment on the motion when recognized by the Committee Chair
- 6. After each attendee at the meeting has had the opportunity to comment on the proposal the initiator will have the opportunity to respond to any comments
- 7. If necessary each attendee at the meeting will once again have the opportunity to comment on the proposal when recognized by the Committee Chair
- 8. After each attendee has had the opportunity to speak a second time the initiator will once again have the opportunity to respond to any comments
- 9. At the conclusion of the discussion the motion will be voted on.
